The Governors and staff at The King's are particularly proud of the welcoming and stimulating environment that we provide for our students. However, we are continually looking at ways to develop and improve the school, to enhance and enrich the learning experience even further.

Unfortunately, the state of school funding is well documented and, like many schools, The King's does not receive sufficient resources in the school's main budget to be able to provide all the additional educational benefits and opportunities that we would like to offer your children.

Therefore, at the beginning of this academic year, we would like to invite all families to help make a real difference to the school by making a £20 voluntary contribution to our school fund. Anyone who is unable to make this level of donation is welcome to make a smaller contribution and/or perhaps support in other ways by giving time to volunteer in school or help in school PTFA fund-raising events. Of course, families are free to donate a larger amount if circumstances allow. The school fund is a registered charity and we are therefore able to claim Gift Aid back from the Inland Revenue on eligible donations: if you are a taxpayer and complete a Gift Aid declaration, every pound donated by you is worth £1.25 to the school, making your donation go even further!
